Where candidates have been unable to attend an AMEE conference in the last five years, due to reasons given in their personal statement, other equivalent scholarly contributions to AMEE will be considered by the AMEE Fellowship Committee.

Examples of actively contributing to AMEE include:

- ASPIRE-to-Excellence activity
- participation in an AMEE committee, special interest group (SIG) or community of practice
- active reviewing for *Medical Teacher*
- active reviewing for *MedEdPublish*
- contributing to an AMEE conference through reviewing abstracts, acting as a chairperson or opening discussant
- active contribution to *MedEdWorld* through the submission of articles, news items or resources
- involvement with BEME activities
